Tucson Waldorf School is committed to a tuition program that helps all families realize their goal of providing an independent Waldorf Education for their children. We strive to make Waldorf Education affordable. To that end, we offer the following:

- **Tuition Assistance:** Tuition assistance is based on total family income, and is available for Grades and 5-day Kindergarten programs (Kindergarten children must be 5 by September 1st, 2016). To apply for tuition assistance, please go to TADS at <http://www.tads.com>. Families are encouraged to apply for scholarships from multiple STOs in Arizona.
- **AWSF:** Families also have the opportunity to raise tuition through the *Arizona Waldorf Scholarship Foundation* which allows Arizona State taxpayers to recommend a portion of their taxes directly to a child's tuition at TWS. (AWSF funds can only be applied to grades and 5-day Kindergarten programs--Kindergarten children must be 5 by September 1st, 2016).
- **Sibling Discount** We offer a sibling discount of 10% off tuition for the second child enrolled in our school. This discount increases to 30% for the third child and any additional siblings.

Application and Re-enrollment

New Applicants: There is a non-refundable fee of \$100 per child due at the time of application.

Returning Students: The enrollment fee is reduced to \$50 for returning students during the first 2-weeks of enrollment for the upcoming school year. After the two weeks, the enrollment fee for all students is \$100.

Payment Information

Tuition may be paid in full, semi-annually, or spread over 10 or 12 monthly installments. All payments will be made through TADS at <http://www.tads.com>. There is a \$500 non-refundable deposit due with signed financial agreement by March 31st. This deposit is reduced to \$250 for families applying for tuition assistance and will be due 15 days after notification of award. The non-refundable deposit will be applied to the gross annual tuition.

Parent Council Fee

Early Morning Care & Extended Day:

*7:30am - 8:30am for Early Childhood through grade 2: Sign-in required at the North entrance.

*7:45am - 8:30am for grades 3-8: Sign-in at the South entrance.

All early morning care and extended day is billed at \$7.00 per hour, assessed on the ¼ hour. Early morning care fees begin prior to ringing of school bell. Extended day billing begins at dismissal and ends at pick-up.

Extended day is offered until 5:30pm Monday through Friday for EC and grades 1-8. There are a *limited* number of Early Childhood drop-in spaces available each day for children needing to stay beyond their enrolled pick-up time. **Please note there is a \$1 per minute charge if you pick your child up after 5:30pm closure—this applies to ec and grades extended day.**
